2021 Mt. Carmel Sta. Rita Hills Pinot Noir

ABV: 13.5% pH: 3.59 Oak: 39% new French oak for 17 months

Established in 1989, Mt. Carmel is home to the acclaimed Sta. Rita Hills appellation. An extremely cool and windy site, Mt. Carmel is primarily dry-farmed, which ensures the roots of the vines dig deep into the site's exceptional diatomaceous earth soils, producing a wine that is both energetic and intricate. The harmonious palate highlights the grand energy and depth, embodying the character of Sta. Rita Hills. This wine is unapologetically delicious.



2021 Gap's Crown Vineyard Pinot Noir

ABV: 14.1% pH: 3.63 Oak: 41% new French oak for 17 months

Gap's Crown Vineyard is considered by many to be one of the best representations of what the Petaluma Gap AVA, the southern component of Sonoma Coast, is all about. Comprised of four carefully selected clones and utilizing a combination of fermentation vessels that include stainless steel, concrete, and wood, this wine possesses a magical quality—its consistent excellence year after year is a testament to its unwavering nature.



2020 Cerise Vineyard Anderson Valley Pinot Noir

ABV: 14.2% pH: 3.72 Oak: 44% new French oak for 18 months

Over the past quarter-century, the Anderson Valley has emerged as the source for some of California's most distinctive wines and Cerise as one of the valley's most preeminent vineyards. Rising from 587 to 1,620 feet, its steep, unforgiving terrain results in thought-provoking wines that combine an untamable spirit with arresting energy and opulence. A medley of red and black cherry is encompassed by zesty blood-orange flavors, giving this wine a deep, soulful character—intensely satisfying.
